ARTICLE VIII; ELECTIONS

Section 1: Regular General Election. ~~The election of officers of the Commonwealth provided for by article II article III and article V of this Constitution shall be held on the first Sunday in November. -- This election shall be~~ The regular general election of the Commonwealth shall be held on the first Sunday in November.

Section 2: Other Elections. Other elections shall be held as provided by law.

Section 3: Election Procedures. The legislature ~~shall by law~~ may provide for the registration of voters, ~~the nomination of candidates,~~ absentee voting, secrecy in voting, ~~the administration of elections, the~~ resolution of election contests, and ~~all~~ other matters with respect to election procedures.

Section 4: Taking Office After Elections. All Officers elected at the regular general election shall take office on the second Monday of January of the year following the year in which the election was held.
