By now I hope you are fully recovered from the events at Brad's house. Howard Mantel has written us that you are back on Saipan and drafting legislation for the IPA project. I trust that all is going well.

As you know, we have been assembling materials for bound volumes. After the conclusion of the approval process in Washington, we expect that the set will total seven volumes. Five of these volumes have been completed. We are, however, experiencing difficulty in getting copies of the verbatim and summary journals and of the resolutions, both as introduced in the Convention and as adopted and subsequently signed by the President and Secretary.
