SUBJECT:

Taxation of Peace Corps Volunteers

The attached cable was received over the weekend from the Office of the General Counsel, ACTION/Washington. It replies to your request for their opinion as to whether a Peace Corps Volunteer's living allowance could be considered a "stipend". You will note that they believe the living allowance might be so considered, depending upon the definition of "stipend" used or intended by the T.T. Senate Bill No. 7-93 contains no such definition.

So that the issue can be formally and finally resolved, I am hereby requesting that the Trust Territory Administration recommend to the Congress of Micronesia that S.B. No. 7-93 be amended so as to specifically exclude Peace Corps Volunteers serving in Micronesia from the provisions of the bill. It appears to me that such a course of action, if approved by the Congress, will end the need for further judicial opinions.

I appreciate the assistance you have rendered in the past and wish to thank you again for your help in this matter.
