SAIPAN — U.S.
Secretary of State Cyrus
Vance and Secretary of the
Interior Cecil Andrus have
invited Micronesian
leaders to a "round table"
meeting in Washington in
April or May.

The invitation was made
in a letter to Congress of
Micronesia (COM) Senate
President Tosiwo
Nakayama and House
Speaker Bethwel Henry.

The letter assured the
COM leadership of "our
interest in close U.S.
relations with Micronesia"
and expressed confidence
"that we can negotiate an
agreement on the future
status of Micronesia that
will serve the interests of
the people Micronesia and
the United States."

The top Carter aides said
the United States is now
reviewing its policy toward
Micronesia and expects to
complete it before the
meeting with the
Micronesian represent-
atives.

The exact date of the
meeting will be decided
later by both sides, officials
said.
