




REFERRAL OF DELEGATE PROPOSAL

FINANCE, LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND OTHER MATTERS


Delegate proposal number 26 requires the approval of the exercise of eminent domain powers on Tinian or Rota by the municipal government of the affected island.

Although the Convention referred this proposal to the Committee on Personal Rights and Natural Resources, this Committee believes that the proposal falls within the matters assigned to the Committee on Finance, Local Government and Other Matters. The Committee believes that all the powers to be accorded local government should be considered together. For this reason the Committee recommends that this delegate proposal be referred to the Committee on Finance, Local Government and Other Matters.


