TO: Delegates to the Constitutional ConventionFROM: Lorenzo I. Guerrero, PresidentSUBJECT: Convention Schedule

The Committee on Organization and Procedures recommends that the following procedures be followed in considering the provisions of the draft Constitution on second and final reading. These procedures are designed to ensure that the Convention completes its work on schedule and that all proposed amendments are given careful consideration by the responsible committee and by the Convention as a whole.

 We will begin considering provisions of the Constitution on second reading on Monday, November 22, at 9:00 a.m. Attached is a schedule of the order in which we will be considering the provisions; the provisions have been listed out of sequence in order to permit more flexibility. We have also set a proposed schedule for discussing these provisions and completing this process by Tuesday, November 30, 1976. It is necessary to allow some time before December 6 for a final technical and style review of the Constitution by counsel and to consider a section-by-section analysis of the document being prepared by counsel. In order to meet this timetable, it may be necessary to meet in the evenings as well as during the days from this point forward.

2. All proposed amendments to constitutional provisions must be submitted in writing to the Secretary of the Convention at least 48 hours before the article is scheduled to be considered by the Convention. The deadlines for submission of amendments are also marked on the attached schedule. Only those amendments submitted in writing and on time will be considered by the Convention.

3. Each substantive committee should meet to consider proposed amendments to provisions within the committee's jurisdiction. The committee should be prepared to take a position on each amendment. Regardless of the committee's position, however, each amendment submitted on time by a delegate in writing will be discussed and voted upon by the Convention.

I urge the cooperation of all the delegates in complying with this schedule.
