PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE II, SECTION 3

It is proposed that article II, section 3 of the draft Constitution be amended to read as follows:

Section 3: Composition of the House of Representatives.

- a) The House of Representatives shall consist of thirty-(30)

 fifteen (15) members with twenty-five-(25) thirteen (13) members from

 Saipan and including the islands north of Saipan, three-(3) one (1) members

 from Rota and two-(2) one (1) members from Tinian and including Aguiguan

 provided, however, that the number of representatives may be increased to

 not more than forty-(40) twenty (20). The term of office for representatives

 shall be two (2) years. In elections for representatives, including those for

 nomination, each elector may cast the number of votes equal to the number of

 candidates running for the House of Representatives from the respective island

 or islands. Each elector may cast his votes for one (1) candidate or distribute

 them among the several candidates. The candidates receiving the highest number

 of votes shall be declared elected.
- b) A representative shall be a qualified voter of the Gommonwealth

 Northern Marianas, a United States citizen or national, at least twenty-one (21)

 years of age, and a resident of the Gommonwealth Northern Marianas for at least
 three (3) years immediately preceding his election. A longer residency requirement may be provided by law.
