

PROPOSED AMENDMENT  
TO ARTICLE XII, SECTION 5

It is proposed that article XII, section 5 of the draft  
Constitution be amended to read as follows:

Section 5: Corporations. A corporation shall be deemed to be a  
person of Northern Marianas descent so long as it is incorporated in the  
Commonwealth, has its principal place of business in the Commonwealth, has  
directors at least fifty-one percent of whom are persons of the Northern  
Marianas descent and has voting shares at least fifty-one percent of which  
are owned by persons of Northern Marianas descent as defined by Section 4.  
No corporation shall be formed for the sole purpose of holding an interest  
in land.
