PROPOSED AMENDMENT
TO ARTICLE II, SECTION 11

It is proposed that article II, section 11 of the draft Constitution be amended to read as follows:

Section 11: Legislative Compensation. The members of the ~~legislature shall receive an annual salary of twelve thousand dollars~~ senate shall receive an annual salary of fourteen thousand dollars plus reasonable expenses provided by law and the members of the house of representatives shall receive an annual salary of twelve thousand dollars plus reasonable expenses as provided by law. The salary of members may be increased no more frequently than once every four years and only upon the recommendation of an advisory commission to be established by law to study and make recommendations concerning the compensation of Commonwealth executive, legislative and judicial officers. No increase in the salary of the members of the legislature shall apply to the legislature which enacted the same.
