PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE IX, SECTION 2, SUBSECTIONS a) AND d)

It is proposed that article IX, section 2, subsections a) and d) of the draft Constitution be amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Referendum. The people may reject any act of the legislature by referendum.

- a) A referendum petition shall contain the full text of the law that is sought to be rejected, and shall be signed by a number of qualified weters equal to If the law is a local law that affects only one municipality, the petition shall be signed by at least twenty percent of the total number of persons qualified to vote within the municipality. If the law is a general law for the Commonwealth, the petition shall be signed by at least twenty percent of the total number of qualified votes persons qualified to vote within the Commonwealth.
- d) A referendum petition submitted-to-the-voters concerning a local law that affects only one municipality shall take effect if approved by a majority of the votes cast by qualified voters within the municipality.

 A referendum petition concerning a general law for the Commonwealth shall take effect if approved by a majority of the votes cast by qualified voters of the Commonwealth. and-the A law that is the subject of the an approved petition shall become null, void and be repealed thirty days after the date of the election unless the referendum petition otherwise provides:
