## PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE II, SECTION 2(a) and (b)

It is proposed that article II, section 2(a) and (b) of the draft Constitution be amended to read as follows:

## Section 2: Composition of the Senate.

- (a) The Senate shall consist of nine six members with three two members elected at large from Rota, three two members elected at large from Saipan and the islands north of it, and three two members elected at large from Tinian and Aguiguan. The term of office for senator shall be four years except that the candidate receiving the third highest number of votes in the first election for senator on each island pursuant to this section shall serve a term of two years.
- members and three two members shall be elected from the islands north of Saipan at the first regular general election after the population of these islands exceeds one thousand persons. The senator receiving the third highest number of votes in the first such election shall serve for two years.

## PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE II, SECTION 3(a)

It is proposed that article II, section 3(a) of the draft constitution be amended to read as follows:

## Section 3: Composition of the House of Representatives.

(a) The house of representatives shall consist of thirty Sixteen Sixteen Sixteen savanteen members with twenty-five fourteen members from Saipan and the islands north of Saipan, three two members from Rota and two one members from Tinian and Aguiguan provided, however, that the number of representatives may be increased by law to not more than forty twenty. The term of office fro representative shall be two years.
