CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSAL NO. 2 - 85

A PROPOSAL

To amend Section 2 a) of Article VI to the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands to restrict eligibility of mayor to persons of Northern Marianas Descent.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION:

1	Section 1. Section 2 a) of Article VI of
2	the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands
3	is hereby amended to read as follows:
4	Section 2. A mayor shall be qualified to vote
5	in the Commonwealth, a person of Northern Marianas
6	Descent, at least twenty-five years of age, a resi-
7	dent and domiciliary of the Commonwealth for at
8	least three years immediately preceding the date
9	on which the mayor takes office, and shall meet
10	other qualification provided by law. No person
11	convicted of a felony in the Commonweatlh or in an
12	area under the jurisdiction of the United States
13	may be eligible for this office unless a full pardon
14	has been granted.

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE DRAFT NO. 1

A RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO REQUESTING THE COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE TO EXTEND THE CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION FOR AN ADDITIONAL TEN (10) DAY PERIOD. WHEREAS, under Public Law No. 4-30, the Constitutional Convention was only 1 allocated thirty (30) calendar days to complete its work on the Constitution; and 2 WHEREAS, while some of the 315 proposals introduced to amend the Constitution 3 are duplicates or matters of legislative concern, additional time is needed to 4 fully discuss the more substantive proposals; and 5 WHEREAS, since this our Second Constitutional Convention, every effort should 6 be made to ensure that another Constitutional Convention will not be required for 7 at least another decade; and 8 WHEREAS, with the shortage of funds, available to the Convention it is not 9 possible to hire independent legal staff or experienced research staff personnel 10 11 sufficient to assist in carrying out our responsibilities efficiently and 12 expeditiously within the time frame allowed under Public Law No 4-30; and WHEREAS, extension of the life of the Convention will necessitate additional 13 funding to cover the costs of the Convention's work in an amount at least proportional 14 15 to funding orginally provided to the Convention; now, therefore NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Second Constitutional Convention that the 16 Fourth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature be and hereby requested to extend 17 the life of the Convention for an additional ten (10) days and provided supplemental 18 funding proportional to the funding provided for the initial ten (10) days: and 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Convention shall certify and 20 the Convention Secretary shall attest to the adoption of this resolution and transmit 21 22 copies thereof to the speaker of the House and President of the Senate, Fourth Common-23 wealth Legislature 24 25 Date:____ July 14, 1985 26 Offered by : Committee of the Whole 27 28
