To amend Section II of Article III of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands to require the election of the Attorney General for a six year term.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION:


1           Section 1. Section 11 of Article III of the  
2           Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands is  
3           hereby amended to read as follows:


4           "~~The Governor shall appoint an attorney~~  
5           ~~general with the advise and consent of~~  
6           ~~senate~~ shall be elected by the qualified  
7           voters in the Commonwealth for a six (6)  
8           year term. The attorney general shall be  
9           responsible for providing legal advice to  
10          the governor, mayors and executive depart-  
11          ments, representing the Commonwealth in all  
12          legal matters, and prosecuting violations  
13          of Commonwealth law.


