
To amend Section 1 of Article V of the Northern Marianas Constitution relating to representation in the United States.


BE IT ADOPTED BY THE SECOND CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION:


1 Section 1. Section 1 of Article V of the Northern Marianas Constitution
2 is hereby amended to read as follows:


3 "Section 1. Representative to the United States. A representative
4 to the United States shall be elected to represent the Commonwealth in the
5 United States, including relations with the United States Government, the
6 government of the states within the territories associated with the United
7 States, such as Puerto Rico, Guam, the Virgin Islands, Federated States of
8 Micronesia, Republic of Belau and the Republic of the Marshalls and to perform
9 those related duties provided by law. THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROVIDE A CERTIFICATION
10 OF SELECTION PROMPTLY TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF STATE AND TO THE
11 REPRESENTATIVE!"
