A PROPOSAL

TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF THE NORTHERN MARIANA
ISLANDS TO ESTABLISH A NUCLEAR FREE ZONE

BE IT ADOPTED BY THE SECOND NORTHERN MARIANAS CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION

Section 1. Nuclear Free Zone


a) There shall not be any test by detonation or dispose
of any nuclear weapon, nor test, dispose of, or discharge any
toxic chemical or biological weapon; or test dispose of, or
discharge any other radioactive, toxic or biological materials.


b) There shall not be any store of any toxic chemical
weapon, nor any radioactive materials nor any toxic chemical
materials intended for weapons use, other than for transit or
overflight purpose or during time of a national emergency
declared by the President of the United States, a state of war
declared by the congress of the United States; or as neccessary
to defend against an actual or impending armed attack.


c) No material or substance referred to in this section
shall be store except in an amount and manner which will not
be hazardous to public health or safety.


