## SECOND NORTHERN MARIANAS CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION, 1985

## A PROPOSAL

To amend Section 2(a) of Article II of the Northern Marianas Constitution relating to Composition of the Senate.

BE IT ADOPTED BY THE SECOND CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION:

Section 1. Section 2(a) of Article II of the Northern Marianas
Constitution is hereby amended to read as follows:

3

"Section 2: Composition of the Senate.

"a) The senate shall consist of MIN# ten with three 4 members elected at large from each of the three senatorial 5 districts. The first senatorial district shall consist 6 of Tinian and Aguiguan, and the third senatorial district 7 8 shall consist of Saipan and the islands north of it. The lieutenant governor shall serve as the tenth and non-voting 9 member, and shall serve as the president of the senate. 10 The senate shall be increased to twelve members and three 11 members shall be elected at large from a fourth senatorial 12 district consisting of the islands north of Saipan at the 13 first regular general election after the population of 14 these islands exceeds one thousand persons." 15
