A RESOLUTION

HELATIVE TO REQUESTING THE COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATERS TO EXTEND THE CONSTITUTE LAL CONVENTION FOR THE ADDITIONAL THIRTY DAY PERSOD.

WHEREAS, under Public Law No. 4-30, the Constitutional
Conve. for was only allocated thirty (30) calender days to
complete their work on the Constitution; and
WHEREAS, with the volume of proposals that have been
introduced during the first three (3) days of the Convention,
it seeems clear that thirty (30) calender days will not be

7 sufficient to devote the time needed to make decisions on the

8 various proposals; and

9 WHEREAS, since this is our Second Constitutional Convention,

every effort should be made to ensure that another Constitutional

11 Convertion will not be required for at least another decade; and

12 WHEREAS, with the shortage of funds, available to the

13 Convention, it is not possible to hire independent legal staff or

14 experienced research staff personnel to assist in carrying out

15 our responsibilities efficiently and expeditially within the

16 time fram allowed under Public Law No. 4-30,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Second Contitutional

18 Convention that the Fourth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legis-

19 lature be and hereby is requested to extend the life of the

20 convention for an additional thirty (30) days.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Convention

22 shall certify and the Convention Secretary shall attest to the

23 adoption of this resolution and transmit copy to the Speaker

24 of the House and President of the Senate, Fourth Commonwealth

25 Legislature.
