RESOLUTION NO: 4-85

A RESOLUTION

Requesting the Governor and the Director of Public Works to waive all utility charges for power and water ^{at} to the meeting place of the Constitutional Convention, the House of Taga, for the duration of the Convention.

1 WHEREAS, it was not practicable to utilize a government facility
2 as the meeting place for the Second Northern Marianas Constitutional
3 Convention; and

4 WHEREAS, Section 17(a) of Public Law 4-30 provides that "The
5 Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House
6 of Representatives shall cooperate and make available, to the
7 greatest extent practicable, the resources of the executive and
8 legislative branches to support the tasks and activities of the
9 Convention and the Pre-Convention Committee, at the lowest possible
10 cost to the Government, and this provision shall apply to all the
11 factors of accommodations, facilities, equipment, and staff support;"
12 and

13 WHEREAS, Section 17(b) of Public Law 4-30 provides that the
14 Convention ". . . shall utilize the resources of the executive and
15 legislative branches to the greatest extent practicable;" and

16 WHEREAS, the Facility Rental Agreement for the Convention meeting
17 place, The House of Taga, provides, in part, that ". . . the ConCon
18 shall employ its best efforts to obtain official Government support in
19 waiving the utility fees for power and water services during the term
20 of this Agreement;" now, therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Second Northern Marianas Constitutional

1 Convention, 1985, that the Governor and the Director of Public Works
2 be and hereby are requested to waive the utility fees for power and
3 water services to The House of Taga for the duration of the
4 Constitutional Convention; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Convention shall
6 certify and the Convention Secretary shall attest to the adoption
7 hereof and thereafter transmit certified copies to the Governor
8 and the Director of Public Works.
