## A PROPOSAL

NOT TO REVAMP BUT SIMPLY TO IMPROVE OR AMEND SECTION 13 OF ARTICLE III OF THE NORTHERN MARIANAS CONSTITUTION RELATIVE TO THE ELECTION OF MEMBERS TO THE COMMONWEALTH STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

BE IT ADOPTED BY THE SECOND CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION:

Section 1. Section 13 of Article III of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands is hereby amended by adding subsections a), b), and c) to read as follows: "Section 13. Department of Education. The legislature shall establish a department of education that shall be headed by a fupetintedndert
 by an elected Board of Pducation. (INLETE the rest of the santences in section 13, Article III and ADD the following subsections).
a) The state Board of Education shell consist of seven(7) elected members, including a student member and three(3) nonvoting ex-cificio members. The three nonvoting members shell consist of: one(1) member selected by an exclusive bargaining representative of the teachers within the Deperment of Fducation; cne(1) member appointed by the Governor from those perzons nominated ly nonpublic schools to represent nonpublic schools; and one(1) member appointed by the Governor from those persons nominated by the Chamber of Commerce to represent the business community.
b) The student board member shall be a public school sophmore or junior at the time of a selection and shall serve for a term of one(1) year beginning on June first of the year a selection is certified by the director of education. The student member shall selected by a plurality vote of sophmores and juniors and seniors atterding public schools, voting in an election in the public high schools on a day in May of each year. be provided by the Board of Education.

| c) The election provided for in this subsection shall be |

| nonpartisan. There shall not be any endorsement, sponsorship, or |
| nomination, directly or indirectly, by any political party on any |
| candidates for this office, Election shall be at-large for candidates |
| from Rota and Tinian. Candidates from Saipan shall be elected by |
| election precincts. The person receiving the highest number of votes |
| in Saipan shall serve for four (4) years. The person receiving the |
| highest number of votes in Rota and Tinfan collectively shall also serve |
| for four (4) years. The person receiving the second highest number of |
| votes in Saipan, finian, and Rota shall each serve for two( 2 ) years. |
