
A PROPOSAL

To establish the offices of special assistants
to the governor.

BE IT PROPOSED that a new section is added to Article III of the Constitution as follows:

"Section _____. Special Assistants to the Governor. The Governor may appoint, without the advice and consent of the Legislature, special assistants in charge of administration, public affairs, press relations, and community affairs, and a personal secretary. The special assistant for administration may be appointed by the governor to serve as the chief of staff of the Governor's Executive Office. These persons may not be forced, except by the order of the court, to divulge any information regarding their official duties and responsibilities without the express consent of the governor."
