Dear Mr. Chairman:

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed amendment of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands. The Delegate proposal No. 119-85 is in line with purpose of the Economic Development Loan Fund to encourage local participation in the business activities in the Commonwealth.

We urgently need a constitutional restriction of foreign business infiltration in the Northern Marianas which are presently operating and competing with our local businesses. Businesses that requires little know-how with minimal capitalization, such as retail, auto shop, restaurant and night club, travel and tour services, entertainment and amusement center, gift shops and numerous other business activities should be owned solely by our local people. Businesses which requires large sum of investments and high technological requirements, may be owned by foreign with an opportunity for local participation.

The effect of such a restriction for local participation is two-folds:

- 1. Local people will participate in the business opportunities available in the Commonwealth.
- 2. Income generated by the businesses will be retained and circulated within the Commonwealth.

I suggest that your committee increase the \$100,000.00 investment requirement to \$1,000,000.00 on Section 4. This will discourage foreign business ownership if investment is less than \$1 million. In addition, require the Legislature to pass a bill identifying the type of businesses which are reserved for Northern Marianas citizens. Delegate Lorenzo I. Guerrero July 2, 1985 Page 2
