<u>Delegate Proposal</u>	<u>Subject</u>	<u>Disposition by Committee</u>
2-85 (Mendiola et al.)	Northern Marianas Descent qualification for Mayor.	Committee not satisfied with AG's response and still under further review.
40-85 (Mundo et al.)	To establish Municipal Council for Tinian and Rota.	In consultation with the introducer, the Committee will incorporate the concerns into Delegate Proposal No. 118-85.
73-85 (Pangelinan)	To abolish the offices of Resident Department Heads for Rota and Tinian.	In consultation with the introducer and after public hearings conducted on Saipan, Rota and Tinian, proposal is filed.
74-85 (Manglona et al.)	Other government employment for Mayor.	The Committee adopted the proposal with amendment.
75-85 (Manglona et al.)	Responsibilities of Mayor.	Pending legal opinion.
91-85 (Calvo et al.)	Change Rota to Luta.	Committee adopted as amended.
98-85 (Mendiola et al.)	Election of Mayor.	Adopted with amendment.
109-85 (Igitol et al.)	To abolish the Mayor's office on Saipan and replace it with precinct commissioners.	Public hearing scheduled for July 9, 1985.
118-85 (Manglona et al.)	To establish municipal Councils for Saipan, Rota and Tinian; given certain powers, and for other purposes.	Committee conducted public hearings on Saipan, Rota and Tinian. Committee will incorporate other proposals concern into this proposal. Cmte report will follow.
124-85 (Mundo et al.)	To delete Section 6(a) and (b) of Article VI of NMI Constitution in its entirety.	In consultation with the introducer, proposal will be filed provided that the concerns raised thereof are incorporated into DP No. 118-85.
136-85 (Limes)	Advice and consent by Governor's Council to all appointments of boards and commissions.	Action held pending outcome of other proposals and under further review by Committee.
137-85 (Limes)	Governor's Council shall review/approve proposed annual budget prior to submission to the Legislature.	Committee filed proposal upon consultation with introducer.
151-85 (Mafnas et al.)	To delete Article VI of the NMI Constitution in its entirety.	Committee filed proposal in consultation with introducer. Cmte also conducted public hearings on Saipan, Tinian and Rota. Cmte report will follow.
154-85 (Mafnas et al.)	Appointed Governor's Rep. for Rota and Tinian instead of elected Mayor.	Cmte conducted public hearings on Rota and Tinian. Cmte report will follow.

250-85 (Villanueva et al.)	To abolish the Mayor's Office on the Northern Islands and replace it with an elected member to the House of Representatives... effective in the 1989 general election.	Scheduled for public hearing on July 9, 1985.
251-85 (Villanueva et al.)	To abolish the Mayor's Office on Saipan and replace it with elected Village Commissioners...and shall become effective in the 1989 general election.	Scheduled for public hearing on July 9, 1985.
255-85 (King et al.)	To provide equal compensation for Tinian and Rota Department Heads at the same level as Division Chiefs on Saipan.	Adopted in principle and to be incorporated into DP No. 118-85.
257-85 (Limes)	To authorize the mayors and governor to act by executive order whenever the Legislature fails to perform a constitutional responsibility.	Pending response from introducer. Need specificity.
261-85 (L.I. Guerrero et al.)	To provide that Resident Dept. Heads from Rota and Tinian shall report to their respective mayorsand upon the concurrence of the Legislative Delegation, a mayor...may remove a resident department heads under their jurisdiction.	Adopted with amendment and to be incorporated into DP No. 118-85.
284-85 and 289-85 (Manglona et al.)	Election of Mayor and Assistant Mayor for Rota, Tinian and Saipan.	Adopted with amendment and to be incorporated into DP No. 118-85.
301-85 (Torres et al.)	Election of Mayor for Rota and Tinian; election of Precinct Commissioners for Saipan.	Adopted in principle and will be incorporated into DP Nos. 109-85 and 118-85.
310-85 (H.T. Guerrero)	To repeal and reenact Section 6(b) of Article VI to permit the incorporation of villages.	Need consultation with introducer.
