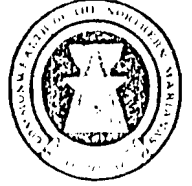



THE HEARING WILL REVIEW PROPOSALS TO AMEND ARTICLE V OF THE CONSTITUTION IN MATTERS RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF THE WASHINGTON REPRESENTATIVE.

- Proposal 12-85: Amends qualifications to being "...a person of Northern Marianas descent..."; deletes requirement of "...a citizen of the United States..."
- Proposal 29-85: Amends term of office to 4 years.
- Proposal 43-85: Amends location of "conviction of felony" to areas within and beyond U.S. jurisdiction.
- Proposal 67-85: Deletes Article V and adds a Section 20 to Article III; Governor appoints representative for four years, with confirmation of Legislature.
- Proposal 71-85: Specifies the particular governmental entities with which the representative would liaise.
