A PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

To amend Section 17 b) of Article III of the Northern Mariana Islands Constitution.

BE IT ADOPTED BY THE SECOND CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION:

Upon ratification pursuant to Section 5 of Article XVIII of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Constitution and Public Law No. 4-30, the Constitution of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands is amended to read as follows:

Effective upon ratification, Section 17 b) of Article III is 1

hereby amended to read: 2

> Public services on Rota and Tinian shall be supervised by a resident department head in the department providing the services appointed by the head of the executive branch department with the advice and consent of the majority of the members of the legislature from the senatorial district in which the resident department head shall serve. A resident department head may not be appointed to serve in any board, commission, or authority. The same arrangements shall apply to the islands north of Saipan when the population of these islands exceeds one thousand persons."
