The Committee on Governmental Institutions recommends to the Convention adoption of the attached. proposed constitutional amendment. The amendment is with respect to the age and residency qualification of persons who may hold the office of governor.

The Committee's recommended constitutional amendment will increase the age requirement from thirty (30) years to thirty-five (35) years and the residency requirement from seven (7) to ten (10) years.

The increase in the age requirement will assure that individuals with more practical and academic experience would hold the office of governor. increase in the residency requirement will insure that persons holding the office of governor will have attained a greater opportunity to understand the strength, potentials and needs of the Commonwealth.

Delegate Proposals: Your Committee considered Delegate Proposal Nos. 7-85 and 23-85 and believes that this amendment is the better approach to addressing the concerns raised.

Your Committee urges all the Convention Delegates to support the recommendation to adopt the attached proposed constitutional amendment.

A PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

To amend Section 2 of Article III of the Northern Marianas Constitution relating to Qualifications of the Governor.

BE IT ADOPTED BY THE SECOND CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION:

Upon ratification pursuant to Section 5 of Article XVIII of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Constitution and Public Law No. 4-30, the Constitution of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands is amended to read as follows:

1	Effectivé upon ratification, Section 2 of Article III is amended
2	to read:
3	"Section 2: Qualifications of the Governor. The governor
4	shall be qualified to vote in the Commonwealth, at least
5	thirty-five years of age, and a resident and domiciliary of the
6	Commonwealth for at least ten years immediately preceding the
7	date on which the governor takes office. A different period of
8	residence and domicile may be provided by law. No person convicted
9	of a felony in the Commonwealth or in any area under the
0	jurisdiction of the United States may be eligible for this office
1	unless a full pardon has been granted."

A PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENOMENT

To amend Section 2 of Article III of the Northern Marianas Constitution relating to Qualifications of the Governor.

BE IT ADOPTED BY THE SECOND CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION:

Upon ratification pursuant to Section 5 of Article XVIII of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Constitution and Public Law No. 4-30, the Constitution of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands is amended as follows:

1. Effective upon ratification, Section 2 of Article III is amended 1 2 to read: "Section 2: Qualifications of the Governor. The governor 3 4 shall be qualified to vote in the Commonwealth, at least thirty-five years of age, and a resident and domiciliary of the 5 6 Commonwealth for at least ten years immediately preceding the 7 date on which the governor takes office. A different period of 8 residence and domicile may be provided by law. No person convicted of a felony in the Commonwealth or in any area under 9 the jurisdiction of the United States may be eliqible for this office unless a full pardon has been granted." 11
