
A PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

To amend Article III of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands relative to Indigenous Affairs.

BE IT ADOPTED BY THE SECOND CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION:

Upon ratification pursuant to Section 5 of Article XVIII of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Constitution and Public Law No. 4-30, the Constitution of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands is amended as follows:

1. Effective upon ratification, Article III of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands is amended to read:
- "Section _____. Resident Executive for Indigenous Affairs.
- a) There is hereby established the Office of Resident Executive to the Governor for Indigenous Affairs. The Governor shall appoint a person with the necessary and sufficient education and experience to be Resident Executive with the advice and consent of the Senate. The term of office shall be four years. Nothing in this section shall preclude renewal of such appointment by the Governor. The Resident Executive may be removed before expiration of term as provided in Article II, Section 8, of this Constitution for incompetence, neglect of duty, commission of a felony, treason, or comption.

- b) Responsibilities of Resident Executive. The duties and responsibilities of the Resident Executive for

2 and private sector.

- 5 - establish a community foundation for the
6 advancement of the Indigenous People.
- 7 - coordinate the translation and distribution
8 of such official documents as the CNMI

11 Cultural Center and the Indigenous Hall of Fame.
- 12 - coordinate and annual cultural festival.
- 13 - develop and implement a long-range plan to
14 assist and promote the entry of the indigenous

17 c) Duration of Office. The Office of Resident Executive
18 for Indigenous Affairs shall commence immediately upon

1 1. Effective upon ratification, Article III of the Constitution of

3 "Section _____. Resident Executive for Indigenous Affairs.

4 a) There is hereby established the Office of
5 Resident Executive to the Governor for Indigenous Affairs.
6 The Governor shall appoint a person with the necessary and
7 sufficient education and experience to be Resident Executive
8 with the advice and consent of the Senate. The term of
9 office shall be four years. Nothing in this section shall
10 preclude renewal of such appointment by the Governor. The
11 Resident Executive may be removed before expiration of term,
12 as provided in Article II, Section 8, of this Constitution
13 for incompetence, neglect of duty, commission of a felony,
14 treason, or comption.
