MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIR, COMMITTEE ON LEGISLATIVE BRANCH AND PUBLIC FINANCE

SUBJECT: Issues Before the Committee With Respect to Article VII (Eligibility to Vote)

Based on the limited number of proposals submitted on this subject, the Committee has at least three issues to consider with respect to this article:

- 1. It has been proposed that the provision directing the legislature to provide criteria by which domicile and residence are determined for voting purposes should be deleted on the grounds that the legislature has already acted.
- 2. It has been suggested that U.S. citizenship alone (and not U.S. national status) be required as a qualification to vote.
- 3. It has been proposed that any person who lives in a Senatorial District for one year should be required to vote in that Senatorial District.
