DELEGATE PROPOSAL NO. 331

DATE: June 5, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Imposes a tax of \$100 each academic year on the parents of each child attending any pre-secondary educational institution in the Commonwealth. Alternatively, parents may contribute 10 hours of school-oriented service each academic year.

Provides that the funds generated by the tax will be used only for educational materials. Any excess will be transferred to the Commonwealth's general fund.

Provides that each educational institution will have total autonomy in the management of the funds raised by the tax on parents by reason of children attending that institution.

Provides that failure to pay the tax can be remedied by a payroll deduction from the parents' place of employment.
