DELEGATE PROPOSAL NO. 335

DATE: June 5, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Decreases the size of the House of Representatives to 5

- 3 from Saipan
- 1 from Rota
- 1 from Tinian

Provides a cap on the size of the House of Representatives at 9 members. No increases in the number of representatives would be permitted unless there was a growth in the population of the island by 15,000.
