There are proposals to amend Article X Sec. 9 of the Constitution to eliminate taxpayer actions. If the Constitution is amended, would it still be possible for taxpayers to file actions challenging the government? More specifically, are taxpayers permitted to file actions absent constitutional or statutes authorization? To what extent are the taxpayers suits be fitted in federal court? What effect would the constitutional amendment have on actions filed in federal court?
