DELEGATE PROPOSAL NO. 324

DATE: June 6, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that the attorney general shall be elected to a four year term of office.

Provides further that a candidate for the office shall be:

- qualified to vote in the CNMI,
- a citizen of the U.S.,
- a member of the CNMI bar,
- a resident of the CNMI for at least five years, unless otherwise provided by law, and
- shall not have been convicted of a felony.
