DELEGATE PROPOSAL NO. 327

DATE: June 6, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that local laws may be enacted by the Legislature or by the municipal council of the district.

Provides that the Legislature shall define the areas in which municipal councils may legislate.

Prohibits the adoption of any local law without a public hearing in the senatorial district affected.
