It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that when the mayor is physically absent from the municipality or the senatorial district in which his municipality is located, the mayor's duties shall be assumed by the presiding officer of the municipal council, except that the presiding officer shall be prohibited from hiring, disciplining, or firing personnel and from reversing any decision made by the mayor.
