A CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION RESOLUTION

To express the appreciation of the Third Constitutional Convention to the House, Senate, and the Legislative Bureau for the generous use of the House Chamber and legislative office space to meet the needs of the Convention.

1           WHEREAS, The Third Constitutional Convention for the Northern  
2 Mariana Islands has been entrusted by Public Law 9-18 with important  
3 responsibilities relating to proposing amendments to the Constitution of the  
4 Northern Mariana Islands; and

5           WHEREAS, the Constitutional Convention requested that the House of  
6 Representatives make its Chamber and office space available to the Convention  
7 in order to provide an economical and efficient setting for the Convention's  
8 deliberations;and

9           WHEREAS, the House of Representatives and the Senate graciously  
10 agreed to make these facilities available to the Convention even though this  
11 would cause considerable inconvenience to the Members of these  
12 distinguished legislative bodies and to the Director and staff of the Legislative  
13 Bureau; and

14           WHEREAS, without the generous cooperation of the Legislature, most  
15 particularly Speaker Diego T. Benavente, and President Juan S. Demapan, and
