THIRD NORTHERN MARIANAS CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION

SUMMARY JOURNAL

Second Day Tuesday, June 6, 1995

- 1. <u>Call to Order</u>: The session was called to order by the President Pro Tem at 10:30 a.m. at the Chambers of the House of Representatives, CNMI Legislature.
- 2. Preliminary Matters: None.
- 3. Roll Call: A roll call by the Convention Clerk showed all delegates present.
- 4. <u>Adoption of Journals</u>: The Summary Journal was approved with certain additions. The delegates were requested to provide their comments regarding the Daily Journal to Mr. Zimmerman within 24 hours so that a corrected version can be presented to the delegates for approval the next day. If no comments are submitted within 24 hours, it will be assumed that the Daily Journal is accurate.
- 5. Reports of Committees: None.
- 6. Introduction of Proposals: After discussion, the Convention approved a procedure for the introduction of proposals. It was agreed that all proposals that had been reviewed with legal counsel, given a number by the Convention Clerk, signed by a delegate, and resubmitted to the Clerk, would be considered as introduced and made part of the Convention's official records. All such are to be attached to the Daily Journal for the day introduced and circulated with the Journal to all the delegates. If a delegate does not wish to introduce a proposal previously signed and submitted, they were asked to identify that proposal by number. In addition, it was made clear that delegates are free to introduce other proposals which, after being given a number by the Clerk, would be made a part of the proceedings and available for assignment to one of the substantive committees. After these procedures were agreed upon, several delegates introduced proposals or identified proposals that they did not wish at this time to be presented to the Convention. (A list of proposals now before the Convention is attached.)

- 8. <u>Unfinished business</u>: The Convention discussed briefly the need for supplemental funding for its activities
- 9. Special Orders of the Day: None.

- 11. <u>Announcements and Miscellaneous Business</u>: The delegates discussed briefly t he production of the Daily Journal and heard remarks from their colleagues.
