DELEGATE PROPOSAL NO. 339

DATE: June 7, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Ensures that when bids are required for a public project, there is included as a standard contract term the requirement that when a change order occurs, there will be a new public notice of 30 days and a new public hearing. If, as a result of the notice and hearing, the government changes contractors, the original contractor will be liable for all costs of the notice and hearing.
