DELEGATE PROPOSAL NO. 341

DATE: June 7, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Reduces the size of the House of Representatives from 18 to 13, with 1 from Tinian and Aquiquan, 1 from Rota, and 11 from Saipan and the Northern Islands.

Reduces the cap on the size of the House of Representatives from 20 to 15 to permit changes required by redistricting that would permit both Rota and Tinian to continue to have one representative.
