THIRD NORTHERN MARIANAS CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION

SUMMARY JOURNAL

Third Day Wednesday, June 7, 1995

- 1. <u>Call to Order</u>: The session was called to order by the President at 10:15 a.m. at the Chambers of the House of Representatives, CNMI Legislature.
- 2. Preliminary Matters: None.
- 3. Roll Call: A roll call by the Convention Clerk showed all delegates present.
- 4. <u>Adoption of Journals</u>: The Daily Journal of June 5 was adopted, with Delegates Villagomez and Manglona noting they had submitted modificat ions. The Summary Journal of June 6 was adopted.
- 5. <u>Reports of Committees</u>: The President announced the appointment of the three Vice-Presidents, the Secretary and the Chairs of the four Committees. The President distributed a list showing which proposals had been referred to which Committee.
- 6. <u>Introduction of Proposals</u>: Delegates Fleming and V. Aldan introduced new proposals. The President introduced two proposals as a courtesy at the request of third parties.
- 7. <u>Motions and resolutions</u>: Two resolutions were passed, one expressing appreciation to the House, Senate and Legislative Bureau for their cooperation and another mourning the death of the late Vice Speaker Mafnas.
- 8. <u>Unfinished business</u>: None.
- 9. Special Orders of the Day: None.
- 10. General Orders of the Day: The President discussed various administrative matters.
- 11. <u>Announcements and Miscellaneous Business</u>: Several delegates expressed their views on a newspaper report on the distribution of seats in the Legislature. Several delegates expressed their preferences for committee assignments. Two of the Committee Chairs invited certain delegates to join their committees. The President announced that he expected to make committee assignments that afternoon. Several delegates expressed their views on the need for unity among the delegates.

There being no further matters before the Convention, the Convention adjourned at 11:35 a.m.
