DELEGATE PROPOSAL NO. 372

DATE: June 9, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Places a cap on damages that may be recovered from the CNMI government by private litigants at \$100,000 to the maximum extent (covering as many types of litigation) permitted under the U.S. Constitution.

Places a cap on damages that may be recovered from private persons by private litigants at \$100,000 to the maximum extent (covering as many types of litigation) permitted under the U.S. Constitution.
