DELEGATE PROPOSAL NO. 379

DATE: June 9, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Restricts the use of Executive Orders by the Governor for reorganization purposes --

1. Executive orders become law if approved by both houses of the legislature or if no single house rejects the Executive Order within 60 days after submission.

2. Executive orders issued for reorganization purposes shall not affect matters under the authority of the Legislature, the Judicial Branch, the Public School System, the Northern Marianas College, the Retirement Board, the Civil Service Commission, or local government.
