DELEGATE PROPOSAL NO. 389

DATE: June 9, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Prohibits any elected official from paying any gratuity to any constituent.

[Note: This is intended to stop the practice of people asking ^{CANDIDATES AND ELECTED OFFICIALS} legislators for money for personal bills and expenses. A gratuity would be defined in the legislative history as a payment to someone who is not in the legislator's immediate family for which nothing is received in return.]
