

DELEGATE PROPOSAL NO. 392

DATE: June 9, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Includes the fairness clauses of Public Law 8-32 as constitutional provisions --

- 1. Limits the amount of contingency fees which may be charged by a lawyer in any matter related to the representation of a client in a legal proceeding or transaction involving real estate in the Commonwealth.
- 2. Provides for the award of equitable adjustments equal to the value of the investment of an adversely affected party where a real property transaction is set aside as void pursuant to the restrictions of Article XII.
- 3. Provides a specified limitations period for alleged violations arising out of Article XII, so that transactions could not be challenged after the passage of that period of time.
- 4. Provides for severance of contractual provisions in transactions involving real property in the Commonwealth which would violate Article XII.
