Delegate Proposal No. 396

Date: June 13, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that the governor, the presiding officers of the legislature, and the chief justice of the supreme court shall have the same salary.

Provides that the lieutenant governor, the members of the legislature, and the presiding judge of the superior court shall have the same salary.

Provides that an increase in salary may not apply to the legislature that enacted it. The salary of the governor and lieutenant governor may not be changed during a term of office.
