Delegate Proposal No. 398

Date: June 13, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Declares that the people have a right to the preservation of the natural, scenic, historic, and aesthetic values of the environment.

Declares that public natural resources of the Commonwealth are the common property of all the people, including the generations to come. As trustee of these resources, the Commonwealth shall conserve and maintain them for the benefit of all the people.
