It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that students in the CNMI school system may be required to speak, read, and write in Chamorro or Carolinian as required subjects.

[Note: it is not possible to limit this requirement to NMI descent students; if it is to be imposed in the Constitution, it must be imposed for all students.]
