Date: June 16, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that the next Constitutional Convention would be held 30 years from the ratification of the amendments proposed by the Third Constitutional Convention.

Provides that the Constitution may be amended by popular initiative within 10 years after the Third Constitutional Convention provided that the petition specifying the specific articles and sections to be amended is signed by 75% of the voters from each Senatorial District. A petition meeting these requirements would be placed on the ballot at the next general election.
