

Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention

Delegate Proposal No. 427

Date: June 16, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that no person elected to an office for a term of more than six months may be employed by any department, agency, or instrumentality of the Commonwealth government other than the office to which that person was elected.

Provides that all elected offices shall have a fair compensation to be appropriated by the Legislature.
