Delegate Proposal No. 440

Date: June 16, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Abolishes the Municipal Councils in all Senatorial districts.

[Note: Mr. Herman Q. Guerrero explains that the existence of municipal councils has no practical function or benefits. The Legislative Delegations of the Legislature presently have the authority and have enacted legislation for their respective municipalities. This is done without additional or noticeable costs.]
