

Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention

Delegate Proposal No. 455

Date: June 17, 1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides that gambling in any senatorial district must be controlled by a gaming commission of seven members:

- . Three from the district where the gambling activities are located.
- . Two from each of the other districts.

Provides that the gaming commission must collect all government revenues from gambling activities and allocate such revenues as follows:

. 30% to the district where the gambling_activities are located.

. 10% to each of the other districts

. 50% to the Commonwealth general fund
