

Third Northern Mariana Islands Constitutional Convention

Delegate Proposal No. 468

Date: June 19,1995

It is proposed that a constitutional amendment be prepared that does the following:

Provides for a sunset provision for the five-year credit under the 1985 amendment limiting such benefot to existing members of the fund on the date of ratification of the new provision.

[The Administrator explains that this means subsequent members will not be entitled to the five-year credit. This amendment will significantly reduce the unfunded liability and effectively correct an obviously erroneous and unfair benefit that has proven to be detrimental to the viability of the fund.]
